Forest Park District 91 Board of Education Special Open Meeting: Board Organization May 2, 2011, 7:00 pm

In attendance: President Frank Mott, Vice President Sean Blaylock, Secretary Mary Win Connor; Board Members Lois Bogajsky, Rafael Rosa, Mary Turek and Joan White; and Board-Member Elect John Tricoci. Also in attendance were Superintendent Dr. Louis Cavallo, and Assistant Superintendent of Operations Edward Brophy.

Audience members included Forest Park Mayor Anthony Calderone; John Tricoci, Sr.; Joseph Tricoci; Jill, Emily, Katie, and Nick Tricoci; Forest Park Review Editor Nick Moroni; and Johan Walsh, League of Women Voters Observer.

The meeting began with roll call and the pledge of allegiance. The District's mission statement and vision statement were read aloud.

The Board unanimously ratified the results of Cook County's canvass of the April 5, 2011 election. Votes were cast as follows for the three seats:

John A. Tricoci, Jr.	1,671
Sean A. Blaylock	1,442
Francis J. Mott	1,396
Rafael Rosa	1,291

Rafael Rosa vacated his seat and was thanked for his service. John Tricoci was welcomed to the Board. The Superintendent presented Raphael Rosa, Sean Blaylock and Frank Mott with token gifts of appreciation from the District for past services. Secretary Connor then administered the oath of office to Tricoci, Blaylock and Mott.

The Board then voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting sine die. Board member Bogajsky was appointed as temporary chairperson, and Secretary Connor as temporary secretary.

Officers were elected for two-year terms. Sean Blaylock and Frank Mott were both nominated for President with Frank Mott presiding on a 3-2 vote (nay Blaylock and White). Sean Blaylock was unanimously elected Vice President, and Mary Turek was unanimously elected Secretary.

Raphael Rosa said it was his pleasure to serve on the Board this past year in an appointed capacity and that he may still attend future meetings from time-to-time.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
