Update on Implementation of IGA with Village of Oak Park and OPPD Lynda Parker, Assistant Last school year, D200 entered into a collaboration with District 97 and the Village of Oak Park to find a balance between the needs to ensure the **safety and security** of our school districts and community, and to ensure we have an equitable, welcoming environment for all of our students. This collaboration led to the development and implementation of an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) between the Village of Oak Park Police Department and Districts 200 and District 97, respectively. Role of SRO, Students of Color, Crisis Planning, Compliance with both Police and School relative to sharing of information, Community Outreach, Lock down/Evacuation drill was able to evacuate in 6 minutes (!!), Discussion along with village regarding safe gun storage,

Six areas for future planning: 1. Continued tri-agency meetings; 2. Ongoing review of IGA

implementation; 3. Guidelines/protocols for law enforcement presence in our schools; 4. Emergency preparedness; 5. Protocols for required Clear and Present Danger reporting; 6. Community engagement.
